GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Participants must be UG/PG/Diploma students from any recognized college/institutions.
- The organizers reserve the right to modify the rules or schedule of the competition as necessary and will communicate any changes to participants in a timely manner.
- Any form of discrimination, harassment, or bullying will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification and potential further disciplinary action.
- Participants must be in good academic standing with their respective institutions at the time of the competition.
- Participants must respect the cultural sensitivities of the audience and avoid any actions or gestures that could be deemed offensive.
- Any disputes or concerns regarding the competition must be brought to the attention of the event organizers in a respectful and timely manner.
- All participants must register online (except events with spot registration) through the official Grand Fiesta-24 website within the specified period.
- Participants must adhere to the submission guidelines provided for each category, ensuring originality and adherence to copyright laws.
- All submissions must meet the specified deadline; late entries will not be considered.
- Participants must refrain from disruptive behaviour during the event, including excessive noise, disturbance to other participants, or disrespectful actions towards event staff.
- Any form of cheating, including plagiarism or collusion with other participants, will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification.
- Participants must follow all instructions given by event organizers and staff promptly.
- Use of profanity, offensive language, or gestures is strictly prohibited.
- Participants are responsible for the safety and security of their belongings; any theft or damage is not the responsibility of the event organizers.
- Smoking, alcohol consumption, or drug use is strictly prohibited.
- Participants should maintain a clean and tidy environment, disposing of waste appropriately.

- Respect for the venue and its facilities, including furniture, equipment, and amenities, is essential.

- Accommodation is available for upon request on a first-come, first-served basis.

INTERCOLLEGIATE SOLO DANCE COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

- Participants must be UG/PG/Diploma students from any recognized college/institutions.
- Participants can choose any dance style of their preference.
- The performance must be between 3 to 5 minutes.
- Participants must register through the official website. The registration will close at 11:59 pm on 17 February 2024. People's Choice.
- Proper discipline should be maintained by each participant or else this may lead to cancellation. Inappropriate or offensive content in performances will lead to disqualification.
- Green room facilities will be provided.
- Costumes and props are allowed but must be brought and managed by the participants themselves.
- Participants must be present and ready backstage at least 30 minutes before their scheduled performance time.
- Participants must adhere to the venue's safety regulations and instructions from the event organizers.
- Participants must provide their own music in a digital format (e.g., USB drive or email) and ensure it is properly labelled with their name and performance title.
- The use of fire, sharp objects, or any other hazardous materials during the performance is strictly prohibited.
- Participants must respect the cultural sensitivities of the audience and avoid any actions or gestures that could be deemed offensive.
- Any disputes or concerns regarding the competition must be brought to the attention of the event organizers in a respectful and timely manner.

INTERCOLLEGIATE MUSIC BAND COMPETITIONS RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Each band must include at least one song recommended by the audience in their setlist.

2. Bands should showcase a variety of genres, ensuring a well-rounded musical experience for the audience.

3. A minimum of one original composition is required per band, encouraging creativity and uniqueness.

4. Time limits for each band's performance should be set to ensure fairness and adherence to the schedule.

5. Bands are encouraged to interact with the audience and convey the story or inspiration behind their original compositions.

6. Judges may evaluate based on musical skill, stage presence, audience engagement, and the seamless integration of recommended songs.

7. Bands should submit their setlist in advance, detailing the audience-recommended song, genres they will cover, and the title of their original composition.

INTERCOLLEGIATE GROUP DANCE COMPETITIONS

RULES & REGULATIONS

- Participants must be UG/PG/Diploma students from any recognized college/institution.
- Only one entry from each college is permitted.
- Time limit is 8-10 minutes for each performance. Negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- Each team may have 6-12 members, including coordinators.
- Choice of songs is open to the participants.
- Participants must provide their own music in a digital format (e.g., USB drive or email) and ensure it is properly labeled with their name and performance title.
- No props will be provided by the coordinators. Participants can carry their own props.
- Dance performances should not convey any indecent gestures.
- Green room facilities will be provided.
- Costumes and props are allowed but must be brought and managed by the participants themselves.
- The use of fire, sharp objects, or any other hazardous materials during the performance is strictly prohibited.
- Decision of the judges will be final.

INTERCOLLEGIATE THEME WALK COMPETITION RULES

1. Registration will close at 11:59 PM on February 17, 2024.

2. Registration can be done via the provided Google Form link, with a registration fee of Rs. 1500 per team.

3. Open for PG/UG/Diploma students from any stream in registered educational institutions.

4. Only one member needs to register from each team.

5. College ID card/authorized letter from the college for each participant is mandatory and should be provided in PDF format during the registration process.

6. All team members should be from the same college/institute.

7. Each team can have a minimum of 7 to a maximum of 15 members. Changing team members will not be permitted after registration.

8. If a team cancels after registering, the amount will not be refunded.

9. The time limit should be 10 minutes (including ramp walk, stage setup, and questioning round by the judges).

10. There is no specific theme, but each group must present their collection based on a theme of their choice.

11. Background narration is allowed.

12. Background music/backdrop must be submitted on Google Drive while reporting at the college.

13. The use of hazardous materials on stage is prohibited.

14. Green room facility is provided.

15. Costumes should be decent and presentable. Vulgarity of any kind will lead to disqualification of the team from the event.

16. Exceeding the time limit will result in negative marking.

17. Tokens will be distributed 2 hours prior to the commencement of the event, and each team must report at the college at least before this.

18. The decision of the judges will be final for all events.

19. Proper discipline should be maintained by each teammate, or else this may lead to cancellation.

20. Participation certificates will be issued to all participants.

21. No participant shall use alcohol or drugs. The use or keeping of these items will lead to immediate disqualification from the event, resulting in the expulsion of the participant from the college campus
